The **Festival Main Stage Events** begin Saturday, June 2 at IKEA's Erie Basin Park (1 Beard Street in Red Hook, Brooklyn) from 2:00 pm-7:00 pm. The 25th Anniversary performances feature a stellar lineup, including [Ronald K. Brown/EVIDENCE](#), [Bombazo Dance Company](#), [Soul Science Lab](#), and [Peliroja](#).

Red Hook Fest attracts over 5,000 people, including local residents and travelers from near and far.
